Together we won more just policies for our state:


- Historic wins to balance our regressive tax code through a Capital Gains tax and funding the Working Families Tax Credit.
- Police reform bills, led by impacted families, will address de-escalation standards, require independent investigations, prohibit certain deadly tactics, and allow decertification/licensing standards for police.
- Community and Technical colleges will better address racial equity.
- HEAL Act, Clean Fuels, and Electric Cars bills will move us toward addressing environmental justice and climate change.
- Tenant protections against evictions, document recording fees for housing stability, and affordable housing investments in the capital budget.
- Immigrant rights: Ban on private prisons in Washington state; civil legal aid for undocumented persons; overtime pay for farmworkers.
- Voting rights restoration for people coming out of prison.
- A statue of Native rights' activist Billy Frank Jr. will replace missionary Marcus Whitman in DC. No Native American mascots for public schools.
- Comprehensive Public Health Districts and Universal Health Care Commission are supported.
